# Harborwalk Projects

## Gilchrist Park – Area 1

- City and contractor are reviewing documentation (construction completion certificate and change order to be signed concurrently) which turn the project back over to the City and allow for the official opening of the park.
- Final pay application and documentation to close out project in accordance with FDOT requirements will still need to be completed by contractor.

# Harborwalk Projects

## Gilchrist Park Restrooms

- **Playground Area** - Received a Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) Determination Document from FEMA revising the playground restroom area from a VE to AE Zone. Pending the 180 day comment period, the revision will become effective February 14, 2018.
- **Area 1** –Engineer is working on submission of LOMR for this area. Staff is looking into the various types of temporary restrooms to be used until permanent facilities are constructed.

- Charlotte County submitted plans for Development Review Committee review on December 15.
