

Chapter 4 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES*

Sec. 4-1. Definitions.

- (a) For the purpose of this chapter, the terms "manufacturer," "distributor," "vendor," "chartered or incorporated clubs," "social clubs," shall be defined and used as they are defined and used in Chapter 561 of the Florida Statutes.
- (b) The term "intoxicating beverages," when used in this chapter shall include all liquors, wines and beers containing more than one percent of alcohol by weight.

Sec. 4-2. Sale of intoxicating beverages--Prohibited to certain persons.

Intoxicating beverages or liquors may not be sold:

- (a) To any person less than twenty-one (21) years of age, actually or apparently.
- (b) To any person who is intoxicated nor to any person who is known to be an habitual drunkard.
- (c) To any patient under the supervision or control of a state hospital, whether such patient be on furlough or otherwise.

(d) Knowingly, to any person who has been convicted by any court for nonsupport of wife or other dependents.

Sec. 4-3. Same--Hours and days restricted.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, offer for sale, serve, dispense, consume or permit to be consumed intoxicating beverages in any place or establishment licensed by the state for sale of such beverages on weekdays between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. seven days a week.
