



Chronic Negligence, Penalty, adding a new Subsection 10.2.5 providing for appeals; and amending Section 10-2.4, "City's Mandatory Lot Mowing Program"; amending Sub-subsection 10-2.4.(k), providing a provision to allow the City Manager the discretion to deny a request for exemption from the City's Mandatory Lot Mowing Program to any person who has previously had said exemption revoked for failure to routinely mow and maintain their property; providing for severability; and providing an effective date.
